How does Student Finance work

- Means tested grant
 - Entitlement is based on gross household income from the previous tax year
 - All household income is taken into consideration , even if its non taxable
- 

Eligibility & Residency requirements

- 2 A Levels or Level 3 or IB or equivalent
- A Student and parent/s must be ordinarily resident in the Island for 5 years prior to the start of the course, or 12 months if they have permanently entitled status.

Tuition Fees – The Facts

For 2018/19 the Fees will be £9,250 for most UK Universities

Q. What if the Fees are over £9,250?

A. Student Finance will only consider paying over this if the course is Medicine, Veterinary or Dentistry.

For an Undergraduate degree Jersey students are normally classed as home students However.... Imperial & Cambridge (and possibly Liverpool University) charge international fees

Students that do not go through our application process risk being charged 'overseas' rates

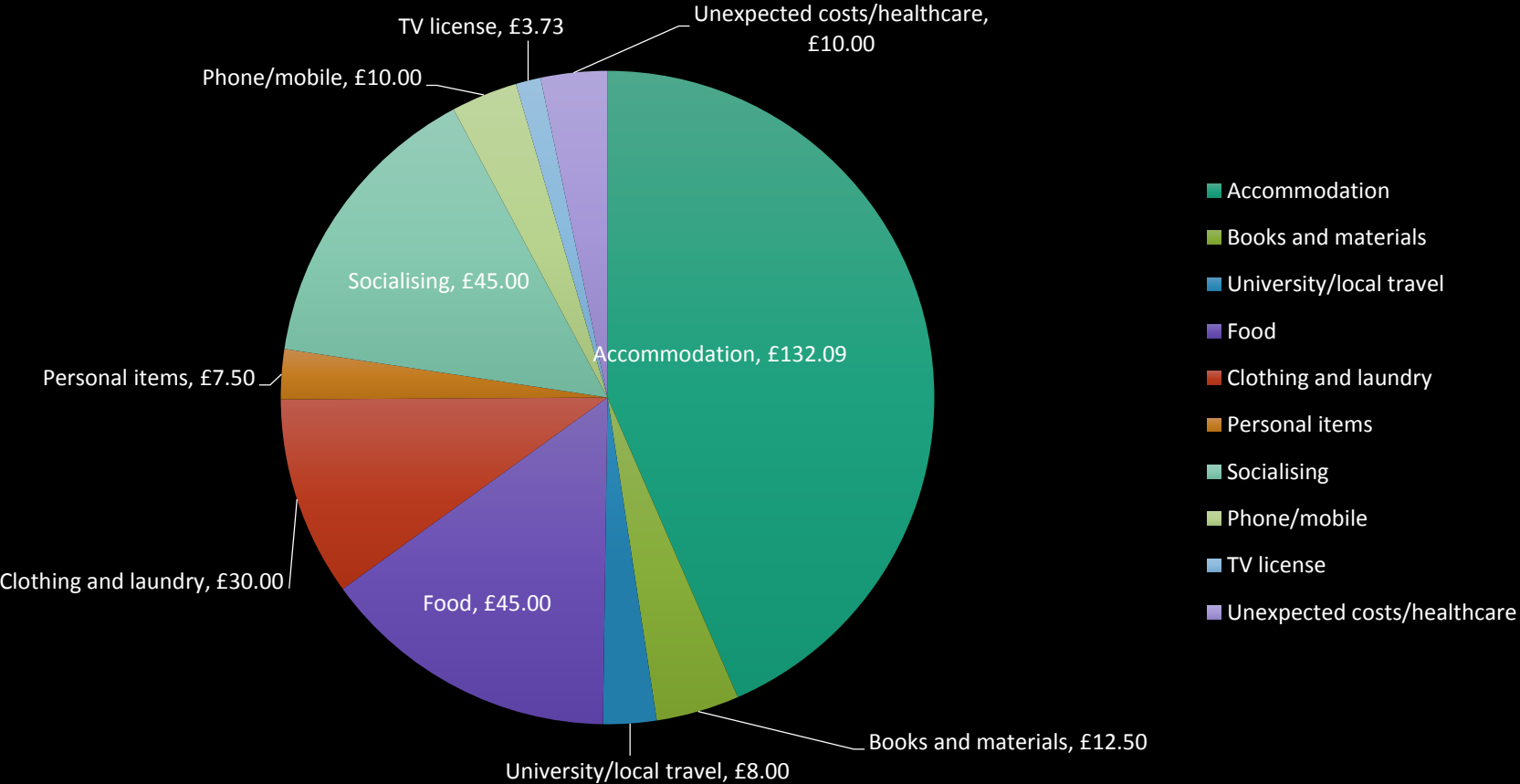
The additional costs during Clinical years of a Medical based degree are covered by Student Finance

Maintenance Grant

A student can receive up to £6,000 towards living expenses on the current legalisation.


How much does it cost per year for a student to 'live' ?

Additional Costs that Student Finance maybe able to assist with


- Disability Support Allowance (DSA) - means tested and non means tested. You must go through the application process to be entitled.
 - Interview Expenses

Studying Abroad

- The entitlement towards fees is the same as a UK University
- It must be the equivalent to a UK degree - some degrees we do not fund with (i.e. Architecture in America)
- Fees to be paid upfront and Student Finance will reimburse parents entitlement once the student has provided confirmation



What if my student withdraws from the course, fails the year or fails to complete the degree initially applied for ?

- The department will ask for a refund of at least 1 terms tuition fees
 - Student Finance do not assist with repeat periods of study
 - If the reason for withdrawal is on medical grounds, Student Finance would take this into account.

January 2018

Application goes Live

June 2018

Deadline for Income Statement Forms to be sent to the Student Finance office (we will also require a copy of your Notice of assessment as soon as you receive this from the Tax Office)

March 2018

Cut off for Student Finance applications for the next academic year

August 2018

Students receive their results and offer letters



March 2018:

- Cut off for Student Finance applications for the next academic year
 - We do accept applications later than this date , but this could affect payment dates
 - Final cut of Date 31st December 2018 - no retrospective application will be accepted
- 



August 2018: Students receive their results and offer letters

- Students must complete the HE7 link - which is sent to them after the initial application
 - A copy of results and offer letter must be provided to the department.
 - We **CANNOT** complete the application process without the above being completed.

What happens next ?

- Once we have ALL the information that we require you will be sent a Notification of Student Award which will show that amount that you are entitled to.
- A Notification of Student Award will also be sent to the University .
- If you are entitled to a maintenance grant - a cheque will be sent to the university for the Student to collect if you are studying on-island or in the UK. Abroad students will have their cheque sent to their bank account.
- If you are entitled to assistance towards fees we will pay this directly to the university - unless you are studying abroad.
