We are holding a drop in event so you can come and speak to her directly about the issues that matter to you.

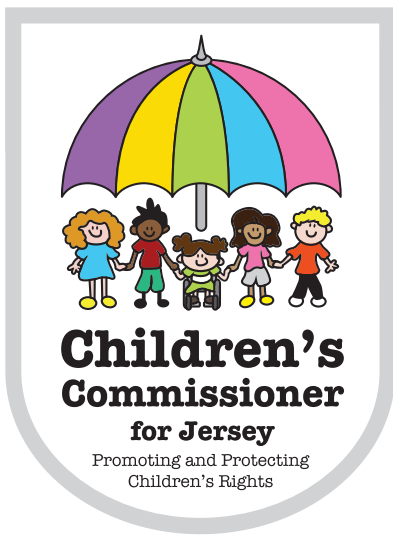
