I would like to take this opportunity to invite you to 'Raising Responsible Teenagers' the first Triple P seminar Hautlieu School is hosting. The evening seminar is being held on Wednesday 11th July from 6.30pm – 8.30pm with doors opening from 6pm.

The Triple P – Positive Parenting Programme - is a parenting and family support system designed to prevent, as well as treat, behavioural and emotional problems in children and teenagers. It aims to prevent problems in the family, school and community before they arise and to create family environments that encourage young people to realise their potential.

Triple P draws on social learning, cognitive behavioural and developmental theory as well as research into risk factors associated with the development of social and behavioural problems in children. It aims to equip parents with the skills and confidence they need to be self-sufficient and to be able to manage family issues without ongoing support.

'Raising Responsible Teenagers' includes information around responsible independence, being respectful and considerate, developing a healthy lifestyle and many more. The Triple P programme is for all parents and Hautlieu are specifically running the teenage programme to support you and your son / daughter. Following the seminar we plan to offer smaller group sessions as required.
