### **March 2022 Mock Exam duration: 3 hours**

<b>March Mock examination paper 2 lens of political and social protest is assessed.</b>

Section B: an analysis of Blake's Songs of Innocence and Experience as examples of political and social protest writing, using at least 4 poems.
Section C: a political and social protest genre essay using The Kite Runner and The Handmaid's Tale.
