March Mock examination topics for revision:

Students will be assessed on their knowledge of Paper 2: Mao's China. Section A will focus on units 3/4 (Jiang Qing) whilst section B will have a choice of two questions, one focusing on unit 2 (Chinese industry) and the other on unit 3 (Cultural Revolution)

Summer 2022 Examinations:

Paper 1: Russia: From Lenin to Yeltsin, 1917-91

Duration: 2 hours 15 minutes. Details: Section A – choice of two essay questions (20 marks); Section B – choice of two essay questions (20 marks); Section C – one compulsory extract analysis question (20 marks) = 60 marks

Paper 2: Mao's China, 1949-76

Duration: 1 hour 30 minutes. Details: Section A – one compulsory source question (20 marks); Section B – choice of two essay questions (20 marks) = 40 marks

Paper 3: Rebellion & Disorder under the Tudors, 1485-1603

Duration: 2 hours 15 minutes. Details: Section A – one compulsory extract analysis question (20 marks); Section B – choice of two essay questions (20 marks); Section C – choice of two essay questions (20 marks) = 60 marks
