- (a) A labelled diagram showing the main features (5-7 detailed descriptive labels);
- (b) An explanation of 5-7 sentences on how they form;
- (c) A map and photo with accompanying description of the location of one or two examples;
- (d) An evaluation of the impacts of these landforms and hazards on human activity (3-5 advantages and disadvantages).
