# Eligibility

## Residency Criteria

- Resident on the Island for 5 years prior to start date of course
- Resident for 12 months if the student or parent hold “Entitled” status prior to start date of course
- A student can take a gap year but must not be out of the island for more than 12 months

## Eligible courses

- Undergraduate Degree Level 4-6
- Some postgraduate courses
- Overseas (Equivalent Education Level)

# Entitlement



**The Student Finance grant is means tested and is calculated annually according to gross annual income and net assets**

- **As a dependent student you are assessed on your parent's gross income**
- **Joint income is over £210,400 or they have assets of over £500,000, there is no entitlement**

# Funding Four Year Courses

## **Courses Including a Placement Year that will receive 100% of your eligible funding for 4 years:**

- **An optional placement, if it lasts at least 21 weeks. This can be for 1 period or several periods that add up to 21 weeks over your entire degree**
- **A mandatory placement, even if it's shorter than 21 weeks**
- **M'Arch – required to practice as an architect**
- **M'Eng – required to practice as an engineer**

## **The following courses will receive 75% of your eligible funding for 4 years**

- **Courses with an integrated foundation year**
- **An integrated masters which Student Finance does not fund**
- **A 4-year without a placement year/year abroad/year industry (for e.g most courses in Scotland)**

**Medicine or Veterinary & Dentistry courses are funded where we will fund up to 6 years**

# OTHER FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

## **DSA (Disabled Student Allowance) :**

- **1:1 Support (not means tested on income)**
- **Equipment /software (If income is below £94,680)**

## **Expenses:**

- **1 amount of up to £258 toward interview expenses - (only eligible if income below £52,600)**
- **Field trip allowances**
- **Vacation study allowances**

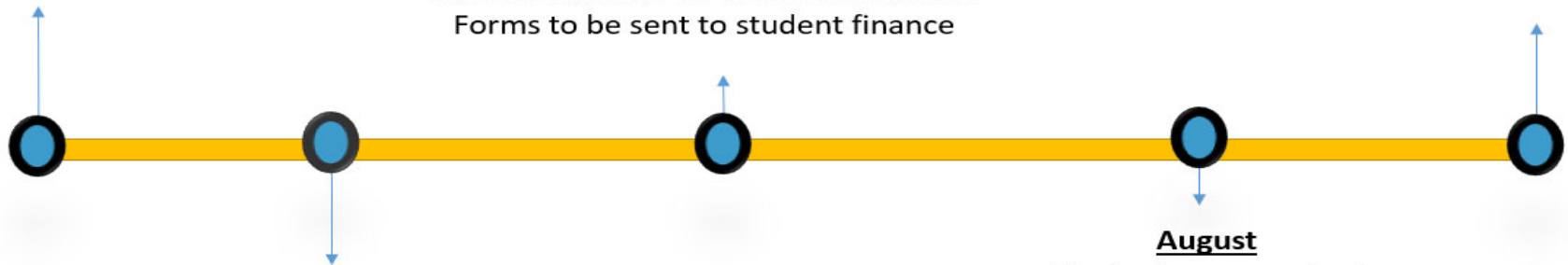

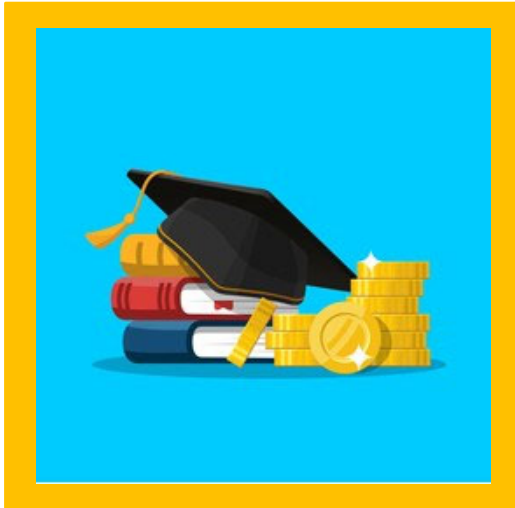

# When Will I Get My Grant and How is it Paid?



## TUITION FEES

- **For a UK or on Island course tuition fees are paid directly to the university termly, Autumn, Spring and Summer – maximum of £9,790**
- **Any parent contribution will be invoiced directly to you by the university**
- **If studying abroad, parents must pay fees directly to the university and we will reimburse on a termly basis in line with how we fund UK universities**

## MAINTENANCE AWARD

- **Maintenance is paid directly into the student's bank account and is paid termly, Autumn, Spring and Summer.**

# Things to Think About

## **What happens if I don't complete my degree?**

**You may be required to repay one terms tuition fees unless you have withdrawn due to medical reasons or other extenuating circumstances. Please contact us for guidance and support if you find yourself in this situation.**
