It is best not to leave this until the night before you begin in September.

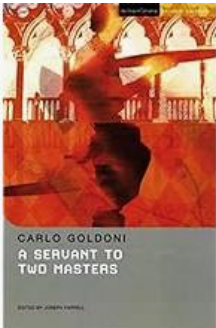
It will be collected by the Drama Department staff in the 1st week of the Autumn Term.

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Task 1 – linked to Component 1 of the course (Drama and Theatre) A study of an important dramatic text.

We will be studying '***A Servant to Two Masters***' by Carlo Goldoni. This is a fast-paced comedy in the style of the Italian 'Commedia dell' Arte'.
